



Save the Date - It's almost Pageant Time!
2018 Miss Osawatomie Informational Sign-Up Meeting
Tuesday, May 15th at 7:00pm at Memorial Hall (411 11th Street)

The Miss Osawatomie Pageant is part of the First Annual Lights on the Lake Festival (formerly known as the John Brown Jamboree) and will be held the evening of June 29th at the OHS Auditorium.

This contest is open to young ladies currently enrolled in K-12th grades and currently residing within the Osawatomie School District & attending Osawatomie schools. It is also open girls residing in Osawatomie who may attend private school elsewhere or are homeschooled but live within the USD #367 District and fall into that age/grade range.

Participation is FREE and participants will have the option of pre-ordering this year's pageant t-shirt for \$15 and the Photo CD of the entire event for \$10 at the sign up meeting. They will also have their picture taken that evening (head & shoulders shot).

There are four separate age divisions (Little Miss, Miss Sweetheart, Princess & Queen)

There are also four different categories that the Contestants will be judged on and they are as follows:

A 5 Minute Interview for the Judges (which will take place the day before the Pageant)

An "Americana" Outfit (which they will wear during the Talent Portion)

The Talent Portion (this can be anything from Jump Roping, Sports Skills, Artwork, Reading from a Favorite Book, Singing, Playing a Musical Instrument to any other talent the contestant wants to "show off")

The Final Category will be Evening Wear.

Any Contestant interested in entering the Pageant **must attend the sign-up meeting**. IF for some reason you are unable to attend this Mandatory meeting you have until **Wednesday, May 23rd** contact the Chamber Office to sign up. **The Committee will not accept any Contestants beyond this date**.
