

Please drop off and pick up your children promptly! Children should arrive no earlier than 8:30 a.m. and should be picked up no later than 11:30 a.m.

Guidelines

- Children should be dressed in comfortable play clothes. Please label their sweaters, hats, boots, etc. with their names.
- Please bring any formula, bottles, diapers, extra clothes or other supplies that your child might need. Please label these items with their names as well.
- Please DO NOT bring toys from home toys will be provided for children to play with at MOMs.
- A nutritious snack will be provided, so we ask that you not send gum or candy with your child.
- Health and Medical History Forms need to be completed before dropping off your child. Immunizations need to be up to date as well. We also request an emergency number, the name of your child's doctor, and the names of anyone who is authorized to pick your child up.
- If your child is sick (fever, unknown rash, or contagious disease) we cannot keep them at MOMs. If your child comes down with a contagious disease the day he or she attended MOMs, please notify the director, Cheryl Townsend at (913) 898-2677, so that she can notify the other parents.
- MOMs cannot be responsible for dispensing medication. Please be sure any prescription medication has already been given to your children before they arrive!
